Spaces will not be reserved for items until full details have been supplied.
4. Please complete and sign the V.A.T. declaration. It is a condition of entry that vendors must inform the Auctioneers if they are registered for V.A.T. and the items entered are assets of that business.
5. All items are accepted on the understanding that they must not be sold prior to being auctioned. Any transactions that occur as a result of exposure in the sale and catalogue must be conducted through the Auctioneers. All lots that are accepted and offered are subject to Thimbleby & Shorland's conditions of sale which are listed in the catalogue and are available on request.
6. Please supply photographs of the vehicles or horses if possible and relevant. The Auctioneers will illustrate the lots in the catalogue at their own discretion, providing the illustrations are clear and accurate.
