CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR THE LIVESTOCK SALE

1. Animals entered for the sale must be registered in the stud book of the Suffolk Horse Society, The Market Hill, Woodbridge, Suffolk IP12 4LU.
2. Animals entered for the sale must be presented in reasonable condition. The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to the sale on the day to any animal considered to be sub-standard. Owners whose animals are refused admission on sub-standard grounds shall forfeit their entry fee.
3. Foals must be a minimum of 5 months of age before being presented for sale separately to their dams and must be fully weaned
4. Owners entering mares in the sale as in-foal must:
 - a) state the date on which the mare was stinted to the stallion and give the name of the stallion
 - b) may, at their discretion, provide a certificate of pregnancy.
5. In the case of any animal not answering the description in the catalogue it may be returned to the vendor by the purchaser within two working days of the date of the sale. The purchaser must state a precise reason/reasons why the animal is returned. Returns may not be made after two working days have elapsed.
6. The veterinary officers attending the sale are authorised to exclude any animal/s which, in their opinion, is/are exhibiting any symptoms of contagious or infectious disease or any other condition which they consider warrants its exclusion. Any owner whose animal is excluded on the above grounds must remove it immediately from the sale ground together with any other animal(s) that has travelled with the excluded animal even if that/those other animal/animals appear healthy.
7. Misuse of Drugs. Tranquilisers or other substances which may affect the normal behaviour of any animal submitted for sale must not have been administered to the animal. In offering the animal for sale on the day the owner undertakes to comply with this condition.
8. Animals must be presented for inspection in the pre-sale ring and trotted on a designated stretch of hard-standing prior to being auctioned.

Livestock Entry Advisory

1. It is desirable that all animals entered for sale have up-to-date inoculation against equine influenza as a minimum. However, lack of vaccination records shall not in itself constitute a reason for refusal of admission.

1. Please complete the entry form for the relevant sections, supplying as much information as possible in order to assist in compiling the catalogue.
2. Please ensure that the entries are of a Heavy Horse nature only – riding and other equestrian equipment will not be included. The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse items which they do not believe to be suitable for this sale, or forward these items to another suitable auction.
3. The closing date for entries is six weeks before the sale but the Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse entries if a section becomes full before this. If a section is not fully subscribed, then the Auctioneers will accept later entries before the catalogue goes to press, at their discretion. Spaces will not be reserved for items until full details have been supplied.
4. Please complete and sign the VAT declaration. It is a condition of entry that Vendors must inform the Auctioneers if they are registered for VAT and the items entered are assets of that business.
5. All items are accepted on the understanding that they must not be sold prior to being auctioned. Any transactions that occur as a result of exposure in the sale and catalogue must be conducted through the Auctioneers, and are subject to standard commission charges as listed above. All lots that are accepted and offered are subject to Thimbleby & Shorland's Conditions of Sale which are listed in the catalogue and are available on request.
6. Please supply photographs of the wagons and implements if possible and relevant. The Auctioneers will illustrate the lots in the catalogue at their own discretion, providing the illustration is clear and accurate.
7. There is a £20.00 entry fee for each horse and wagon entered. Please send this remittance with your entry. No entry fee is necessary for the other sections of the sale.
8. Lots may be delivered to the auction site the day prior to the sale at the Vendors risk, otherwise all lots to be delivered on the morning of the sale.
9. Payment to the Vendors will be made 14 days after the sale date. No interest is payable to Vendors on sales monies held by Auctioneers.
