**PAYMENT:** All lots must be paid for on the day of sale.

Our terms are STRICTLY CASH, BANKER'S DRAFT, DIRECT DEBIT CARDS, CREDIT CARDS with the premium of 2% charge. Cheques will only be accepted from known customers, unless supported by an approved letter of reference from purchasers' bank.

No clearance of goods will be allowed until payment has been made in full.

**MONEY LAUNDERING:** Under the new regulations, if you wish to pay in excess of 15,000 Euros in cash, full identity must be proved. The Auctioneers reserve the right not to accept cash above this limit.

**BUYER'S PREMIUM:** A buyer's premium of 12% including VAT on the premium will be payable by all purchasers at the Reading General Sales.
