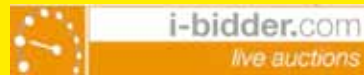

Directions: Scaifs Farm (GU34 3HL) is situated on the B3006 Alton to Selbourne road a short distance south of its junction with the A31. See map on inside back cover of catalogue. Direction signs will be in evidence on viewing and sale days.

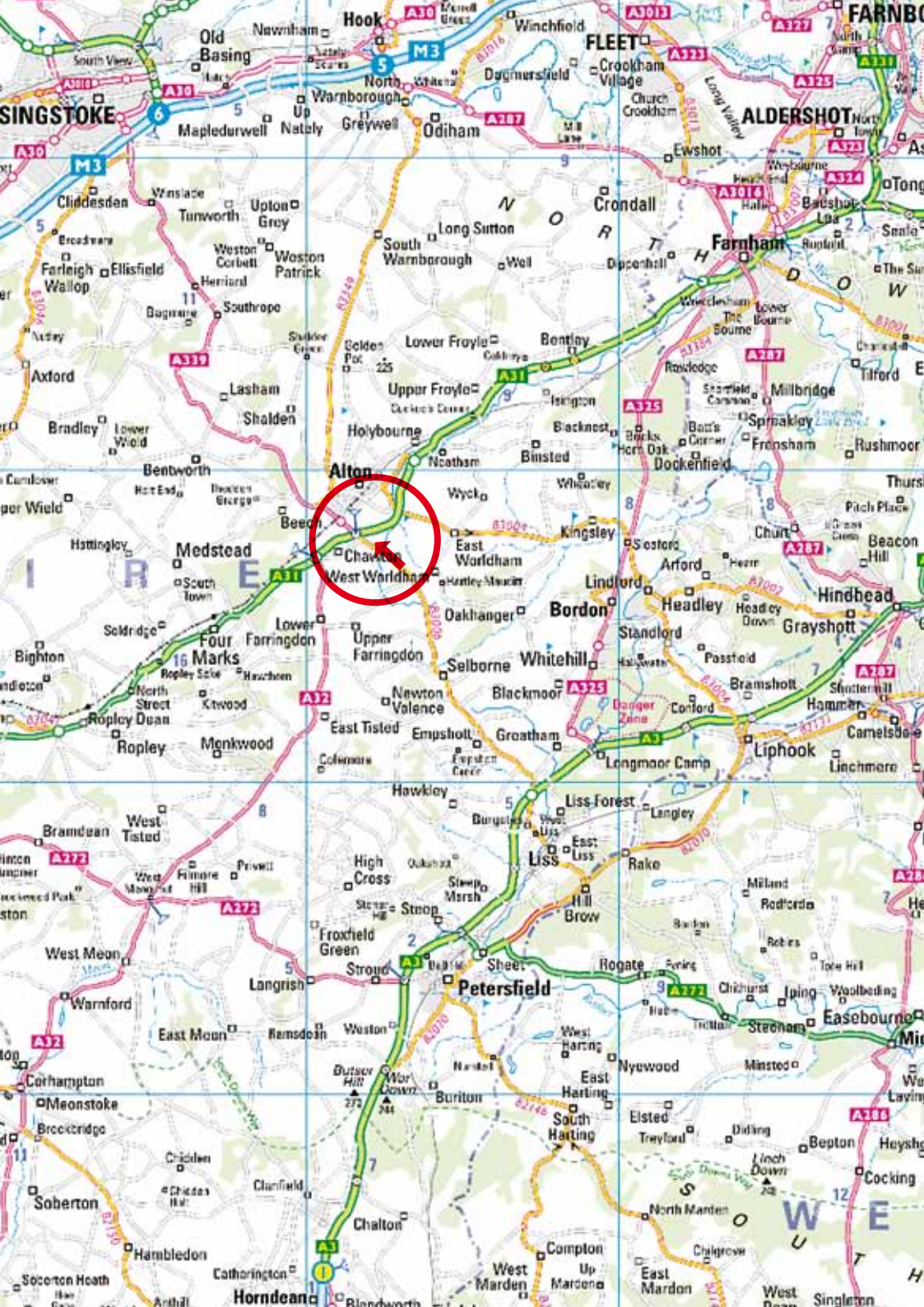
